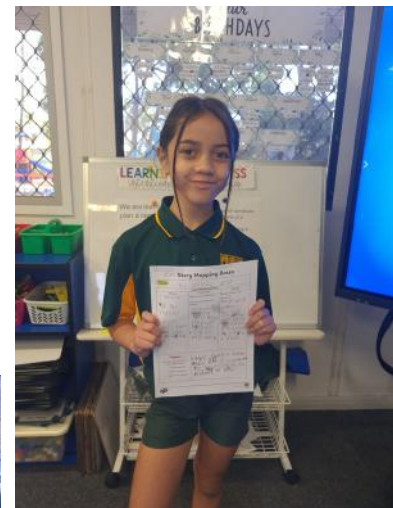
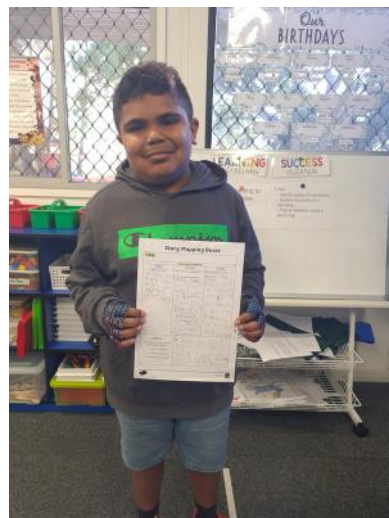
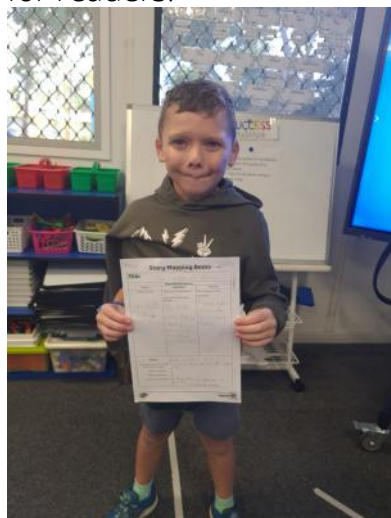
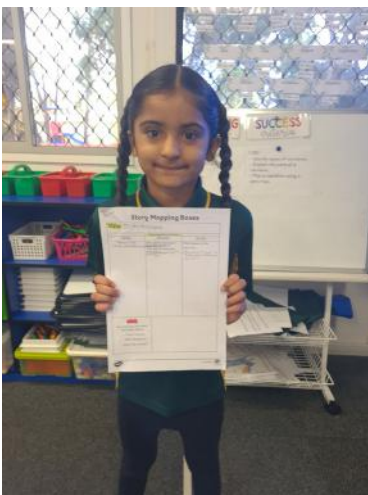
MATH

In maths, this term, our class has been learning about odd and even numbers and being able to identify and explain why a number is odd or even. Skip counting from random numbers, backwards and forwards in 2s, 5s and 10s. Most recently, we have been working on place value and being able to order and represent numbers in different ways.



ENGLISH

This term our class has been learning about narrative writing. We have done this by looking at different types of narrative stories and using story mapping templates to help us plan out our narrative stories to make them more engaging and interesting for readers.

This term, we spent some time in art and HASS Learning about Luna New Year (Chinese New Year). We have done this by reading stories about the holiday and how different cultures celebrated.
