## HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION WITH MR REYNOLDS



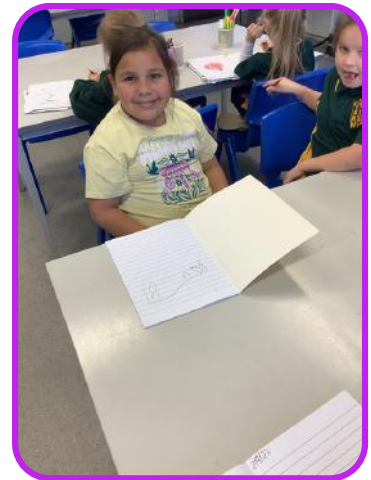
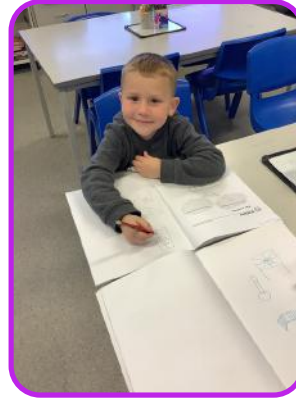
This term, students have been learning to prepare and develop their abilities for activities that they would participate in for Sports Day. The Junior Primary students have participated in small activities that would be used in rotation while the Primary students have improved their practice in athletic events including shot-put, discus, high jump and long jump. They have also been preparing for their class camp with some combined class activities including team challenges and orienteering.

## SCIENCE WITH MR REYNOLDS

In Science, all students have had a focus on Physical Science. Room 7 have been learning about the different physical forces that can be applied to objects and how this changes the movement of these items. Room 5 have been learning about push and pull and have started to create and design their own push and pull toys and playgrounds. Room 8 have been learning about heat: its source, how it is used and conductors and insulators. Room 13 and 15 have learnt about light, energy and electrical circuits as a combination.
