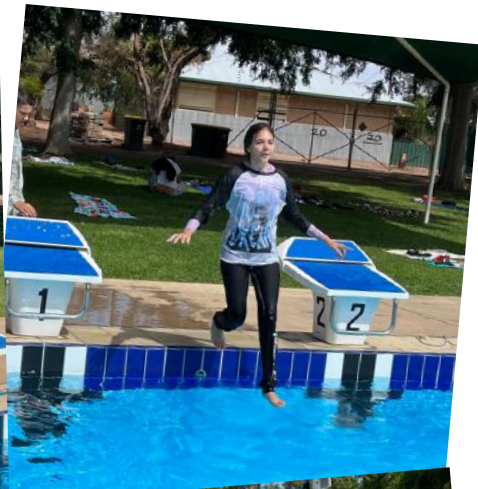


SWIMMING LESSONS

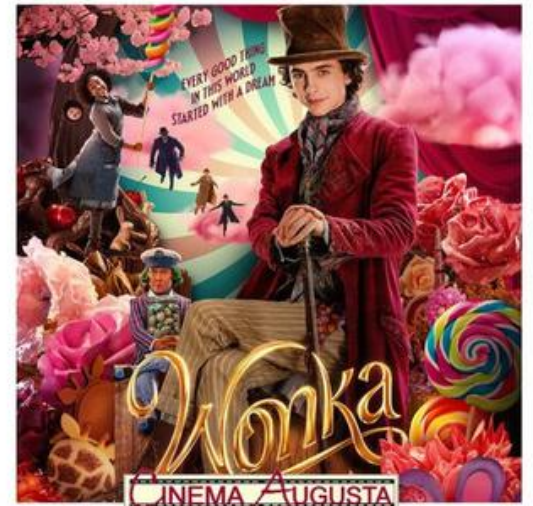
