




MiniLit Program




Our Pedal Prix Race Track






Our class has been learning about length, perimeter and area for two weeks. We have enjoyed creating our own Pedal Prix Race Track during Mathematics. There was a 'TWIST' in what we were allowed to include in our Race Track. We could only use straight lines and corners in the design, we were not allowed to include curves in our track.

After creating our Pedal Prix Race Track we had to measure the length of the sides on the inside and outside of the Track. We were making sure to use the correct unit of centimetres. The next step was to measure the distance around the track or perimeter. Using the lengths we had already measured, we were able to calculate the perimeter for the inside and outside.

The third stage introduced us to using a scale to measure the actual size of the track in real life. We were given a scale of 1cm which is equal to 10m in real life. We used the scale to calculate the size of the track if it was to be built in real life and the distance around the track. We found that the distance for 1 lap to be completed, was similar to the distance of a Pedal Prix Track we are visiting in Pedal Prix. It has been really fun to create.
