On Friday 29th of March, Emma Newbery had the opportunity to represent Willsden Primary School at the 2019 SAPSASA Swimming Championships-Country, in Adelaide, for Northern Districts. Overall, the team had a successful day, with four swimmers making 6 finals between them, a medal won, and many personal bests achieved.

Emma swam exceptionally well on the day achieving success in her 50m Freestyle event, knocking nearly 2 seconds off her long course time and also swimming a long course personal best in her Backstroke swim. In addition to this, Emma swam in two relays. She swam the butterfly leg of the Open Girls 4 x 50 Medley relay. She also brought home the last leg of the 13 yr old girls 4 x 50 Freestyle relay, which was our most successful relay team in years, placing 4th, just 2 seconds shy of a bronze medal.


