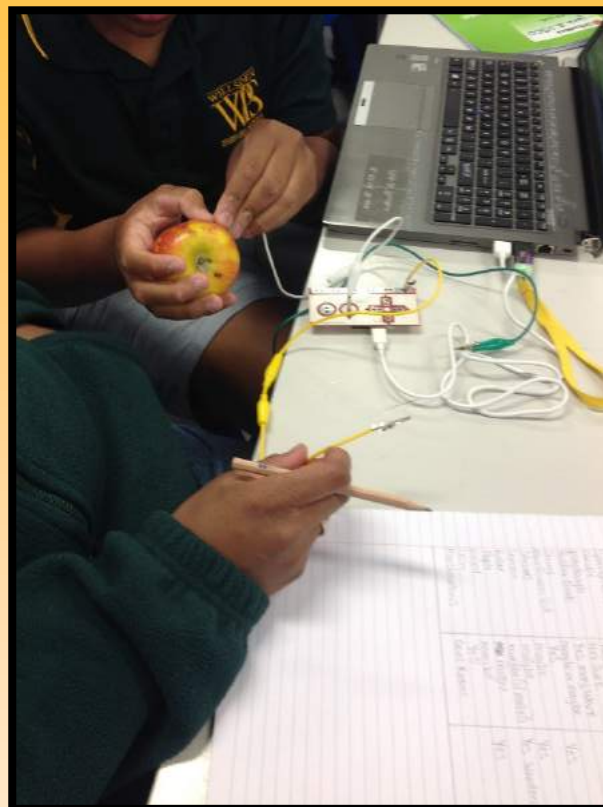
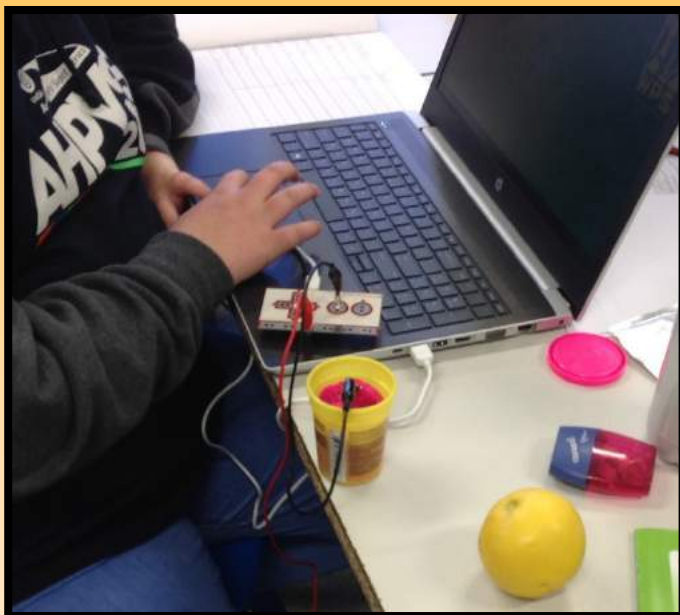

Science and Technologies with Miss Vinall

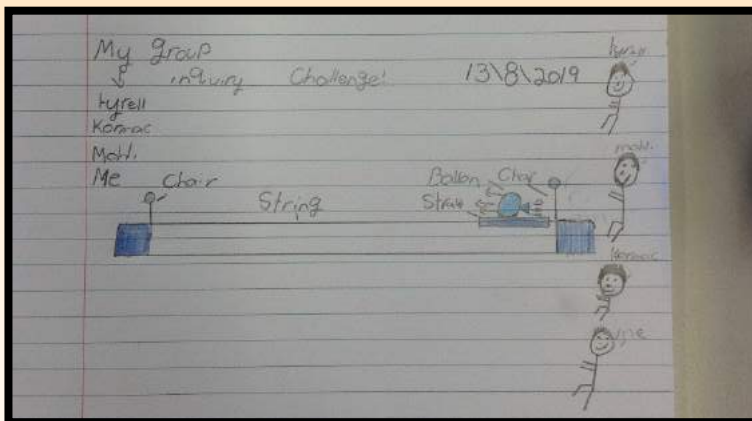
In science we are looking at physical sciences. We have been learning about forces and motion as well as electricity and circuit building.
