Material and Services Rebate

This week the Minister and Premier announced the \$100 discount initiative, which provides a \$100 rebate or discount to eligible parents, caregivers and independent students that have paid their Materials and Services Charge. The \$100 discount will apply for each of the 2022 and 2023 schools years.

If you have paid your fees and are eligible for a refund we will contact you to discuss your options.

If you have fees outstanding this amount will automatically be credited against outstanding fees.

Recipients of School Card are not eligible for the rebate.

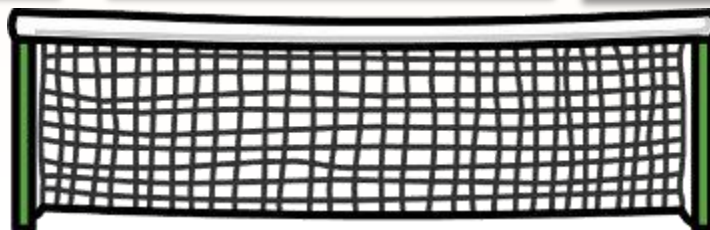

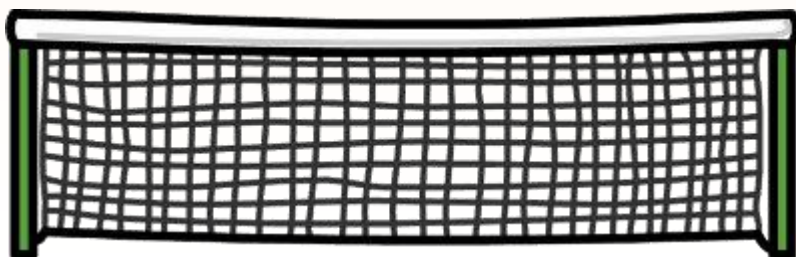


Year 3/4 Tennis Clinic
